On being allocated a bungalow or flat the following conditions will apply:

- You will permit the Trustees to submit your application to the Church of England Pensions Board or one of the Service Associations for their assistance if it is considered necessary.
- You will sign an agreement to observe the rules of the Charity Commissioners' Scheme which include among others:
- Not to absent yourself from the accommodation for more than 24 hours without first notifying the General Manager or one of the Trustees or their appointee
- Not to be absent for more than 7 days at a time or more than 28 days in one year without the consent of the Trustees
- Not to part with possession of any rooms or room allotted to you
- Not to share the occupation of the accommodation. (Other than occasional visits from friends and relations)
- To accept other general clauses to be found in a Licence including a provision that no pets are allowed. (The Trustees do not permit dogs or cats due to the open plan design of the estates).

The Trustees do not currently request any contribution for maintenance, Council Tax or water charge nor do they anticipate having to make one, however they reserve the right to do so in the future if it should become necessary.

By way of reassurance to you, the Trustees confirm that the funds of the charity are sufficient to meet its liabilities for the foreseeable future.

While the Trustees welcome all single Christian female applicants, under the terms of Major Devenish's will, priority will be given to Church of England women if applicants have equal needs. A waiting list is maintained and those in greatest need are housed first, not necessarily the person who has been on the list longest.
